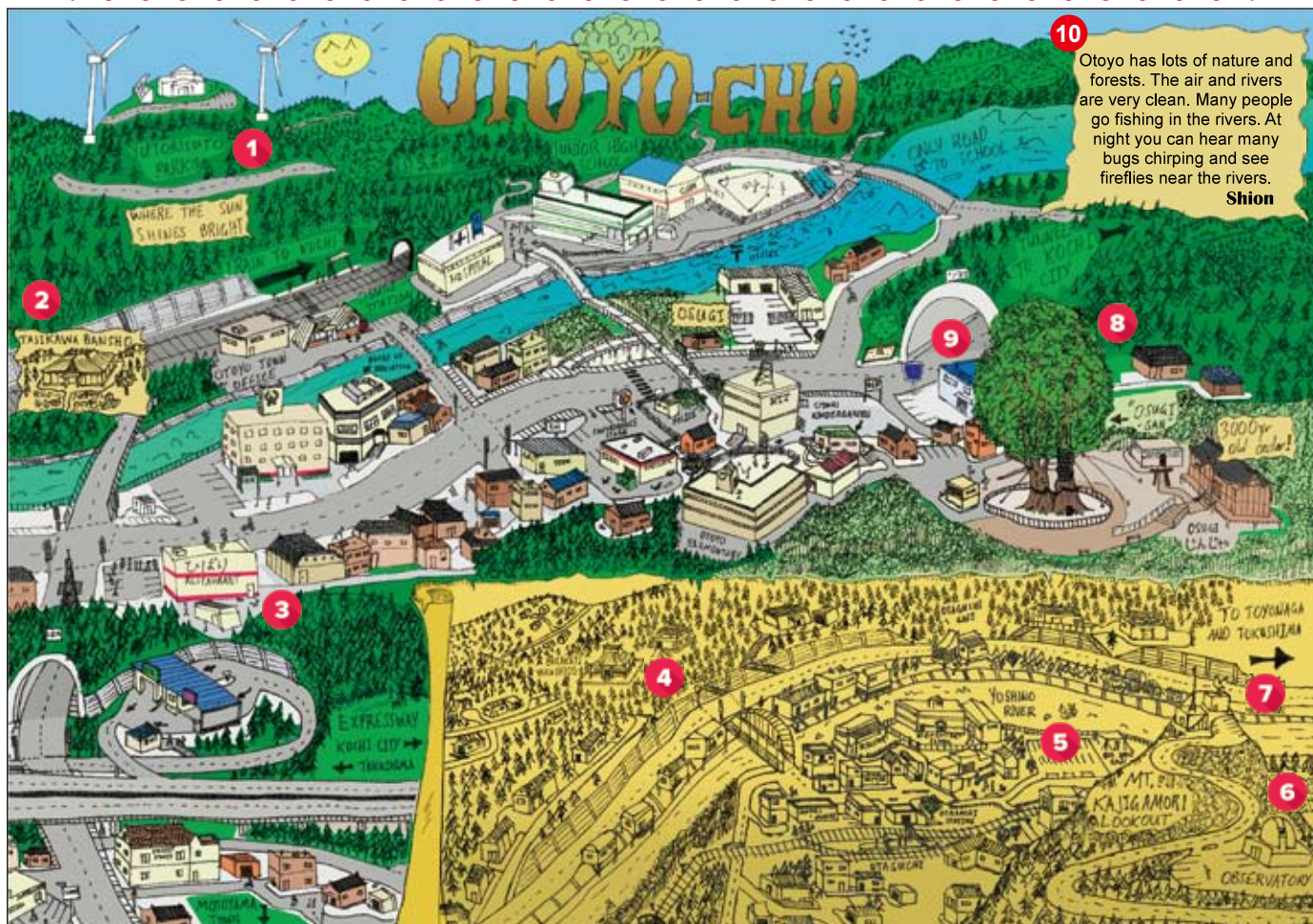


中学生が英語版大豊町パンフレットを作成しました

2 “Tajikawa House was built between 1789 and 1800 but the site was used from 797. It was an alternate home for the Tosa Daimyo from 1718 and a lodge during the Meiji period. It's been on the National Treasures list since 1974. It takes about 20 minutes to drive there from Otoyoyo interchange.”

3 “Hibari is the most popular eating place in Otoyoyo. It is famous because the serving size is very large. It is famous for “Katsu on rice”. It is near the town office. It is said on the internet that it's the place to go for massive meals.”

4 “Burakuji-Yakushido is a Buddhist temple and is the oldest structure in Shikoku. It was built around the 12th century. It is in Terauchi. You can go there by car, train or by walking. It has been on the list of National Treasures since 1952.”

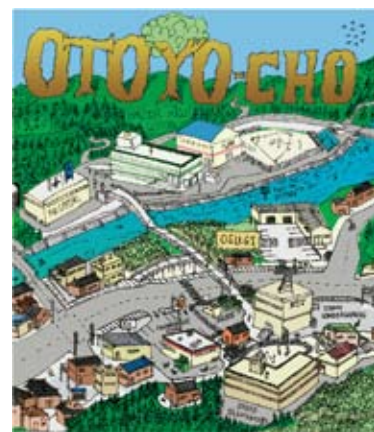
Yuna
